If You Experience Cyber Bullying


- Ignore the comments if they aren't too harmful.

Not Offered Everywhere – Telehealth is still a new technology and not all healthcare providers have this service. This is because some are still hesitant about providing care over a phone or tablet. Doctor's worry that the same quality of care can't be provided.

The effects of IT on employment⁴

Manufacturers used to employ millions of people, but nowadays:

- Skilled workers such as technicians and machine operator maybe **replaced by computer-controlled robots**, which can work quicker and more consistently, for more hours.
- Dirty and dangerous jobs have been **replaced by equipment** fitted with sensors that monitor the environment and report issues.

Office personal used to think that their jobs were relatively safe, but:

- Databases have been enable offices to store data electronically. One person with a database is able to manage
 quantities data, so there is no longer any need for filing clerk.
